

# BlueGolf Scorecard Mobile App

This year, NCGA clubs have been given access to the [BlueGolf Tournament Management](#) software, which has a live mobile scoring feature that allows entering scores and checking the leaderboard on a mobile phone during the round. The BlueGolf Scorecard app (<https://www.bluegolf.com/info/scorecardapp.html>) is used for this, which is virtually identical to the NCGA Events app used by NCGA for their tournaments. Scroll to the bottom of this webpage for links to the Apple and Google store.

We will use live scoring as the preferred option for 2026 tournaments and encourage all our members to download the app. We suggest that a paper scorecard be kept as a backup and way of catching scoring errors. We will still accept paper scorecards and will use them to double check scores entered electronically. **All players: please report to the tournament director to verify your score** (whether entered electronically or on paper by you or someone else).

To use the scorcard app, you will need to enter a personalized “check-in code” (aka. BGID), a six-character code that we will make available with the pairings. This code will not be active until the day of play. If you’ve forgotten the code and cannot navigate to the club’s “[Upcoming Events](#)” page that lists it on the pairings sheet, you may try entering your mobile phone number as an alternative to the check-in code, then check your text messages for a verification code. This works only if your mobile number is associated with your BlueGolf account. Usually, the first to check in is the designated scorer for all players in the foursome, though this can be changed in the app.

As soon as is convenient, we ask that you check your BlueGolf account and update your profile, if necessary. Go to [BlueGolf.com](#) and click “sign in” (NOT “sign up”) near the top right corner. Sign in with your email or mobile number on file (may be the same login as used by GHIN for posting scores). Once signed in, click your initials near the top right corner and select “Profile Settings,” then “Manage contact and personal info.” It is a good idea to keep your profile current, e.g., if we need to communicate by text message last-minute changes such as frost delays or the use of winter rules.

Note to our associate members and LLESA-only members: You are not listed on our club roster as we have not registered you with NCGA to avoid charging you twice for an NCGA membership. Thus, our club has no info on your BlueGolf account. You will, however, appear in the pairings with your own check-in code and should be able to use the scorecard app like our regular members.
