- 3 OB/Lost Ball options, Stroke & Distance or Drop +2. (See LLESA Local Rules for details)
- 4 Unless otherwise stated on the 1st tee, **Winter Rules**. (See LLESA Local Rules for details.)
- 5 Individual score lines on **scorecards must be added up**.
- 6 USGA rules apply throughout the tournament.
- 7 Please arrive at the course at least 30 min prior to your tee time.
- 8 Please maintain your pace of play with the group ahead of you.
- 9 **Golfmart Prizes: 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places in each flight and Closest to Pin on all Par 3s**

Winter Rules

We are using winter rules for the Dublin Ranch event, as follows:

Preferred Lies (Winter Rules) When preferred lies (aka. 'winter rules', 'lift-clean-and-place') are in effect, our club uses the following rules.

Balls in the fairway (Model Local Rule E-3) You may lift, clean, and place the ball if it is in the fairway, including collars and aprons around the green. When doing so, the ball must be placed within one club 1 length, no closer to the hole. The ball may not be lifted from the fringe and placed on the green. It may, however, be placed in the rough.

Balls in the rough (Model Local Rule E-2) If the ball is in the rough (but not in a penalty area), then you may lift, clean, and re-place the ball in the exact same spot, recreating the lie (e.g., replace it deep into the rough if that's where you found it).

Balls in bunkers: All bunkers are to be played as ground under repair (see below)

Ground Under Repair

Due to the poor condition of the bunkers, all bunkers can be played as ground under repair.

This means you can hit the ball from the bunker, if you choose, or take free relief as follows:

To take relief, you must find the nearest point of complete relief (NPCR) from the ground under repair and drop your original ball or another ball away from the ground under repair and within one club-length of that point not nearer the hole. (see Rule 16.1)

This means relief from the bunker only. If the nearest point of relief places you into a bush or tall grass, you must use that as your point of relief. There are other options:

- Hit from the bunker
- Take "back-on-the-line relief" outside the bunker, but you would incur one penalty stroke. See Rule 16.1(c).2. This may make sense in case the NPCR is in a bush, next to a tree, in deep grass, etc.
